

7 Passwords You Should Never Use at Your Small Business

Owning a small business means owning data. You're constantly acquiring new information related to your customers, your financial details, and all the vendors and contractors with whom you work. One cyber criminal, though, one lucky hack, and you've just exposed your business to a major blow. From lost trust among your clients to costly lawsuits for the damage done, protecting your company from data theft is among your most important responsibilities.

A lot of it comes down to one simple choice you make: passwords.

"Overall, passwords still present the biggest challenge for businesses of all sizes," said Ron Schlecht, founder and managing partner of BTB Security. Businesses hire Schlecht's company to test their digital security for weak spots and, he said, "you can't imagine how many times we still break in to companies because of a bad password."

If you want to avoid weak passwords at your business, start by steering clear of the following list. Read on for seven passwords you should never (ever) use.

Password

Arguably, this is the number-one and most common bad choice. Also prevalent are variations such as P@ssword and P@55w0rd!. These might be easy to remember, but they're also among the first options hackers will try.

OWERTY

Easy-to-guess passwords often take root because they're simple to remember. That's the story with this hacker-friendly option constructed from the sequence of letters at the top left of the typical computer keyboard.

12345

Or, 98765. Or, 4567. You get the picture — no consecutive numbers (and the same goes for sequential letter combinations).

You can only count on passwords such as these to expose your business to digital theft.

BusinessName1

If your shop is called Serafina's Weddings, don't set your password as SerafinasWeddings1. That would be a early choice for hackers looking to break into your valuable data.

Business Address

Skip it entirely, when it comes to passwords. Also avoid trying to mash together similar details, such as your street name and street number — i.e. Main215.

Date of Birth

Thanks to the Internet, it doesn't take much effort to find a person's DOB. Birthdays, birthdates, years of birth — all of them make for readily attainable passwords and are poor choices for your company.

Simple Dictionary Words

Especially if they're related to your business, don't use them. No baseball, football, or soccer for your sporting goods store. No muffler, tire, or spark plug for your auto garage.

And so, what should you do when it comes to picking a password?

A key approach starts with thinking of a passphrase. Next, substitute letters, characters, and abbreviations for parts of it. For example, my first car was a Honda in 1990 would be easy enough to remember, if that was the case in your life. Now, change it to my1stc@r=honda90.

Steer clear of the not so magnificent seven above, and protect your data with hard-to-guess constructions. With a strong password strategy, you're well on your way to foiling online attacks.

The drive-thru locations are not able to provide flu vaccines for children enrolled in the Illinois Medicaid Vaccines for Children (VFC) program. Patients who are enrolled with this program will need to coordinate with their primary care office or the local health department.

Appointments for flu vaccines are also available to established patients at HSHS Medical Group primary care clinics in central and southern Illinois. Call your HSHS Medical Group primary care office or use MyHSHS, the HSHS online patient portal, to schedule an appointment.

How to make a vaccine appointment through **MyHSHS**

It is free and easy to create a MyHSHS account and schedule an appointment online:

Login or create a MyHSHS account by clicking "Sign Up Now."

Under Menu, click "COVID-19/Influenza Vaccine Scheduling.'

Click "COVID-19 /Flu Vaccination" and answer questions on eligibility to schedule a flu vaccine, COVID vaccine or both.

You will be able to choose from available appointments at our Springfield, Decatur and O'Fallon drive-thru locations.

Who Should Get a Flu Vaccine

Everyone 6 months and older needs a yearly flu vaccine, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommends. Getting vaccinated is even more important if you or someone you live with is at higher risk for complications from the flu.

This group includes older adults; pregnant women; young children; and people with chronic health problems, such as asthma, diabetes, heart disease or cancer.

People in high-risk groups are more vulnerable to flu complications. They may become very sick if they get the flu. Some may have to go to a hospital.

But remember: Almost everyone should get a new flu vaccine every year. Even healthy people can get sick and pass it on. And past vaccines won't protect you because flu viruses always change.

It takes two weeks to build immunity to the flu virus. So try to get vaccinated by the end of October. That way your body will be ready to fight the flu when it gets here.

MCKENDREE UNIVERSITY **CONTINUES** TO **CELEBRATE** HISTORY-MAKING SUCCESS



The past two years have been especially fruitful for McKendree they continue seeing great success in their Člear

Path initiative.

Within this past year alone, the university has seen an increase in several enrollment aspects, including online undergraduate students (up 12 percent), total graduate student hours (up 23 percent) and total undergraduate students (up 5 percent). There have also been steady increases in several online programs, including the master's in clinical mental health and counseling program, the master's in education in curriculum and design program, the master's in teaching program, the master's in business administration program and the master's in nursing program. Additionally, an impressive amount of interest has been shown in one of the university's newest programs, the Paraprofessional+ Pathway program, a fully online offering for paraprofessionals looking to become full-fledged elementary teachers with initial licensure in only two years.

The university has also seen some of the largest classes in its 195 years of history within the past two years. This year's incoming class has already demonstrated their academic prowess and potential as an astounding 30 percent of new students - up from last year's number by two percent – are receiving honors scholarships. These students hail from 35 states and 28 countries, similar to last year's numbers of 33 states and 30 countries.

This continued success has been attributed to various factors, especially the university's Clear Path initiative. This unique initiative provides transparency in the scholarship and financial aid process for undergraduate students residing in nearby counties that they are guaranteed the personalized experience provided by a private institution at a public school price. This initiative, which began in the fall of 2021 with 34 counties, has recently been extended to include a total of 63 counties in Illinois.

"We continue to be excited about Clear Path and the opportunity it provides to show students from our region how a McKendree education is affordable," said Chris Hall, vice president for admission and financial aid at McKendree University.

McKendree will continue hosting Preview Days this year, which will give visitors the opportunity to learn more about the university's academics, co-curricular activities and campus life during an interactive student-faculty panel and campus tour. This year, Preview Days will take place on Monday, Oct. 9; Saturday, Nov. 11; Monday, Feb. 19, 2024; and Saturday, April 6, 2024. Interested students and parents may register for a Preview Day here.


