Q. How will the interviews be conducted?

A. All interviews will be conducted and recorded in person at the Chamber office. The interview will be hosted by the Chamber's Marketing & Communications Manager, Jonathan Simmons.

Q. What types of questions will be asked?

A. Candidates will be asked a consistent set of questions that focus on leadership, decision-making, and their vision for the community.

Q. How can I prepare for the interview?

A. Once your recording time is confirmed, you will receive a list of questions in advance. We recommend preparing concise and clear responses to effectively communicate your message during the recording.

Q. How long will the interview take?

A. Each interview will last approximately 10-15 minutes.

Q. Where will the podcast be available?

A. The Chamber will actively promote the podcast through our website, social media channels, and email campaigns. Podcasts will be available on major platforms, including Apple Podcasts, Spotify, Amazon Music, and Podbean.

Q. Can I promote my episode after it's released?

A. Absolutely! We encourage candidates to share their episodes to reach as many residents as possible.

Q. What if I need to reschedule my interview?

A. Please notify us at least 48 hours in advance if you need to reschedule.

Q. Will my interview be edited?

A. Yes, but only for clarity and quality purposes. We may make minor edits to remove background noise, enhance audio quality, and ensure a smooth listening experience. However, we do **not** edit content in any way that alters your message or statements. Our goal is to present your responses authentically and accurately.
