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Be an Active Chamber Member

Becoming a member and getting involved in the O'Fallon-Shiloh Chamber of Commerce may be one of the best moves you can make for your business! Does that sound like an overstatement? Your involvement in your Chamber may be vital to your success as a business. Joining the chamber and getting involved offers many benefits, many of which you may not be aware of:

<u>Business-to-Business Referrals</u> – People like to do business with people they know and can trust. When you attend Chamber events, you will get to know a variety of people. When you need a service, use one of your chamber colleague's services and chances are, they won't forget you! If they don't personally need your services, they may refer you to their business associates, friends, family and acquaintances. Every month the Chamber hosts many opportunities to network with other members. The Chamber serves the function of offering business referrals to people in the community.

<u>Learning Opportunities</u> – At many of our meetings, there is a wealth of information that can be learned about business, managing people, professional development and happenings in our community. The charge for these meetings is nominal and is often free.

<u>Volunteer Opportunities</u> – The Chamber works to make our community a better place to live and to do business so that economic growth and stability takes place, which positively affects the entire community for the better. There are many opportunities within the Chamber to serve on various committees or volunteer at events.

We have various committees who are responsible for the vast majority of events and benefits we provide. Not everyone can serve on a committee, but membership on a committee does give the opportunity to provide input on the issues impacting the business community and the Chamber as well as visibility for your business. Our committees meet on a set schedule. Call the Chamber office if you're interested in serving on a committee.

- <u>Ambassadors</u> serve as "goodwill messengers" for the Chamber, welcoming new members and assisting with most Chamber events. We are limited to 20 Ambassadors.
- Golf plans and conducts the annual golf outing for Chamber members and their guests.
- Education facilitates communication between the private and public school systems and encourages discussion between the school systems and the O'Fallon business community. This committee is composed of superintendents representing the local public and private schools. Projects include the annual 8th Grade Career Fair.
- <u>Military Affairs</u> works to build close ties with active duty, retired military and civilian residents of our communities. This Committee supports our military through SAFB Spouse Club airmen dormitories, AFJROTC and other entities. Sponsorship supports Vine Street Market Military Appreciation Days, Holiday Charitable Outreach and Welcome packets etc.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT



Did you know the Chamber offers a Leadership Institute program for young professionals?

The class is open to Emerging leaders between ages 21-40 who live or work in O'Fallon or Shiloh

with demonstrated community involvement or aspirations to become more involved.

Lead In is designed to introduce you to people you might not otherwise meet and provide you education you might not otherwise receive about our community.

We've had a wide range of students complete the program and we encourage you to think "outside the box" when considering colleagues and employees you might refer to apply! Participants must be willing to commit the necessary time to fully participate in the program. The class tuition is \$349, payable prior to the first meeting. Lead In meets one afternoon each month from January to September. Applications are accepted year round with selections being made in mid-December. The deadline to apply for the 2024 class, which starts in January, is Dec. 4, 2023. You can learn more about the program and apply online

MONTHLY/QUARTERLY EVENTS



Business Over Breakfast (BOB)

This informal networking event is for building relationships and features a complimentary continental breakfast. Usually held the last Friday of specific months 8:00-9:00 a.m., at the Public Safety Building. Two 12-minute speaking opportunities are available. Speakers share the cost of the breakfast food items. Average attendance is 25+.



Luncheon Meetings

This event is an educational networking event associated with a lunch. Lunch averages \$18 and are held at a chamber-member business. If you would like to sponsor a speaker for the luncheon, please contact the chamber. Average attendance is 50+.



Restaurant Roulette

This event is a small group luncheon, held on specific months. Location and lunch partners are determined by a virtual roulette wheel. You're randomly assigned a restaurant (we'll let you know the day before where you're eating).

You'll find out who your lunch partners are (4-6 other chamber members) when you show up to eat! This is a fun way to support local restaurants and get a chance to network! You pay for your own lunch. Average attendance is 4-6 per location.



Business After Hours (BAH)

BAH is a premier networking event for Chamber members and their businesses. A BAH offers the host the chance to bring potential customers on site for a first-hand look at the company. Usually held on the third Tuesday of certain months, 5 - 6:30 p.m., at the host sponsor's location. Host Sponsor provides complimentary food, beverages, and attendance prizes. Host pays \$125 to cover printing of "Save the Date Card" and postage. BAHs are scheduled six months in advance. Average attendance is 50+. Consider co-hosting with another chamber member.
